## Moving to boost development

**In June 2018, SteelTech** will move to new, customised premises at the Sävelund industrial park in Alingsås. The company recently signed an agreement with Castellum to develop the property located on Bultgatan 1. The property today is approx. 3,000 m<sup>2</sup> with plans to expand it with around 3,000 m<sup>2</sup> of production space.

“We have held discussions for quite some time about an alternative site thanks to the plans for the new E20 motorway and the development of the so-called A+ area,” says SteelTech’s CEO Björn Sjölin.

“With this new space, we can participate in the design and planning of our production areas as well as office spaces. We are growing constantly, and we will now have a property that is highly adapted to our bu-

siness needs. On top of this, we are really happy that we can remain in the city. The Sävelund industrial park is in a good location that suits our type of business, while the future expansion of the northern bypass will improve access to the area.
