2. Consistent commitment to Pediatric Dermatology (min. 10 years) from any country (Award 1), India (Award 2), or developing/underdeveloped country (Award 3).
3. Current member of the ISPD (membership by time of review).
4. May be self-nominated or nominated by someone else.

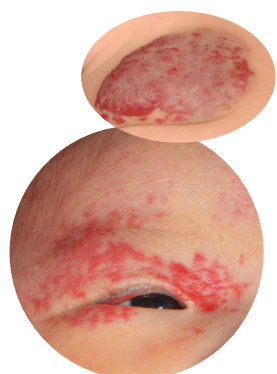
